



Innisfree Creative Gardens Competition Rules & Guidance 2022

Who is eligible to enter?

Any Innisfree tenant may enter the competition, either as an individual or together with other Innisfree tenants. If you want to enter more than one category, please fill out separate forms.

Closing date for entries

EARLY BIRD applications - small grants are available to help you get going.

Applicants who want to receive a small grant voucher towards the cost of preparing their garden must apply by **30 April 2022**.

- £15 for hanging baskets or window boxes
- £20 for a small space patio or balcony/edible garden
- £25 for an individual garden/wildlife garden/communal garden

However, we need proof that your purchases have been used for your garden space. You must get receipts for any purchases and submit these to the office no later than **20 May 2022**. Anyone who has received a grant but not kept the receipts may not be eligible to take part in the competition.

FINAL CLOSING DATE for all entries **1 June 2022**. If possible, please supply photos of the garden before you start work.

Prize Categories

Innisfree will award prizes in the following categories.

- Best individual garden (prize £100 voucher)
- Best hanging baskets or window boxes (prize £50 voucher)
- Spectacular small space patio or balcony (prize £75 voucher)
- Best garden for wildlife (prize £100 voucher)
- Best community project or communal garden with proof of communal working (prize £100 voucher)
- Best edible garden (prize £75 voucher)

Other awards may be made at the discretion of the judges.

The judges will take particular account of gardens which display evidence of consistent effort over a period of time rather than “quick-fix” gardening. They will also be looking for efforts to deal with improving wildlife, climate change and edible foods.

COMPETITION JUDGING – end June 2022

You or someone acting on your behalf will need to be available on the judging date when the judges will call to see your garden.
